Dear Senior of 2018,

Within this document you will find important information regarding your senior pictures. Please pay special attention to this entire document, whether in bold or not.

Just a quick overview of what is due to Ms. O'Brien by Monday, October 2nd, 2017:

- 1. Your senior picture
- 2. Your senior quote
- 3. Your baby picture

We recommend that you have your senior picture taken this summer to make sure that you can make the deadline. **Due to the production schedule, we cannot make extensions.**

First Requirement: The Senior Photo

Picture:

- Must be a formal headshot (head and shoulders only).
- Picture may be either in color or black and white.
- Attire must be neat, clean, and modest in your picture. Students should have a PA appropriate hairstyle. No
 hats or immodest accessories. Males must wear a collared shirt, and be clean-shaven. Females must wear a
 modest neckline with no bare shoulders and no t-shirts.
- Background should be a formal headshot (without props).
- The best results will come from digital originals of your photo.
- If you fail to provide your photo by October 1, or your submission does not comply with our senior portrait guidelines, we will use your regular school portrait.

Dimensions:

- Photo should be a vertical composition, not horizontal.
- Minimum photo size must be 2 x 3 inches at a resolution of 300 ppi.

Second Requirement: A Baby Photo

The senior section will include both senior and baby pictures.

- Please send a digital image. You should scan a larger photo to get a high resolution photo. If you do not have a scanner, you can have a photo scanned at a variety of places (Walgreens, Target, ProEx, National Camera, etc.)
- You should be wearing clothes!
- If you do not meet the deadline, we will not include your baby picture in the yearbook.

Third Requirement: Senior Quote

The senior quote is a longstanding PA tradition and privilege. It is an opportunity for you to sum up your legacy here.

- Your quote must be 50 words or less. It should be only one quote, not multiple quotes.
- You must cite your source. Both the quote and source must be PA appropriate.
- Your quote may be original, but of course, must be appropriate for our whole community.
- It should be proofed with no typographical errors.
- If you do not meet this deadline or your submission is not PA appropriate, you will not have a senior quote in the yearbook.

The Deadline

- Monday, October 2, 2017. This is a firm deadline!
- We will not scan your photos. Email your photos and quote to maggie.obrien@providenceacademy.org with your name in the subject line (or at least within the email).
- Make sure that your photographer will not require us to sign a release for your picture. It will be used in a variety of school related events/publications (Yearbook, Gala, senior slide show, etc.).

PA reserves the right to:

- Edit your photo, only in order to make it compliant with the stated rules (if possible).
- Reject your photo and request a new one (this makes it all the more incumbent upon you to provide your photo to us in a timely manner).
- Reject your submission, in part or whole, if it is not received by Mr. Rousar before October 1.
